Invitation

The University of Münster, the European Virtual Institute for Speciation Analysis (EVISA), and the International Association of Environmental Analytical Chemistry (IAEAC) invite you to participate in the 11th Workshop on Progress in Analytical Methodologies for Trace Metal Speciation.

It is the major objective of the workshop to highlight the value of the enhanced information provided by speciation analysis and to demonstrate and discuss how this information can be used to tackle real-world challenges related to chemical species. Participants are invited to submit contributions for presentations in English on topics within the scope of the workshop.

Scope of the Workshop

The single-stream programme will consist of invited plenary lectures, oral contributions (20 min. including 5 min for discussions) and poster presentations. Session topics are:

- Environmental speciation analysis
- Speciation analysis in proteomics, metallomics and metabolomics
- Speciation analysis for the food and health sector
- Speciation analysis for the characterization of materials and industrial processes
- Tools for speciation analysis

The conference will feature an exhibition of instruments, equipment, leaflets and books. The exhibition will provide an excellently targeted opportunity to present and to learn about the latest scientific and technical developments.

On Tuesday, September 4, 2007, short courses on practical issues related to speciation analysis will be offered. Pre-registration via the conference web site is required.

Abstracts and Manuscripts

Abstracts of contributions to be presented during the conference should be submitted using the abstract form available from the workshop website. Abstracts should be sent as an e-mail attachment to the conference office (TraceSpec2007@speciation.net). **Submission deadline is April 30, 2007.** Authors will be notified of the acceptance of their contribution by May 31, 2007. Authors of accepted contributions are encouraged to submit a manuscript for inclusion into the proceedings volume that will be published as a special issue of the International Journal of Environmental Analytical Chemistry.

- Car: Take the A43 and/or A1 motorway to Münster. You will be in the city centre within a matter of minutes.
